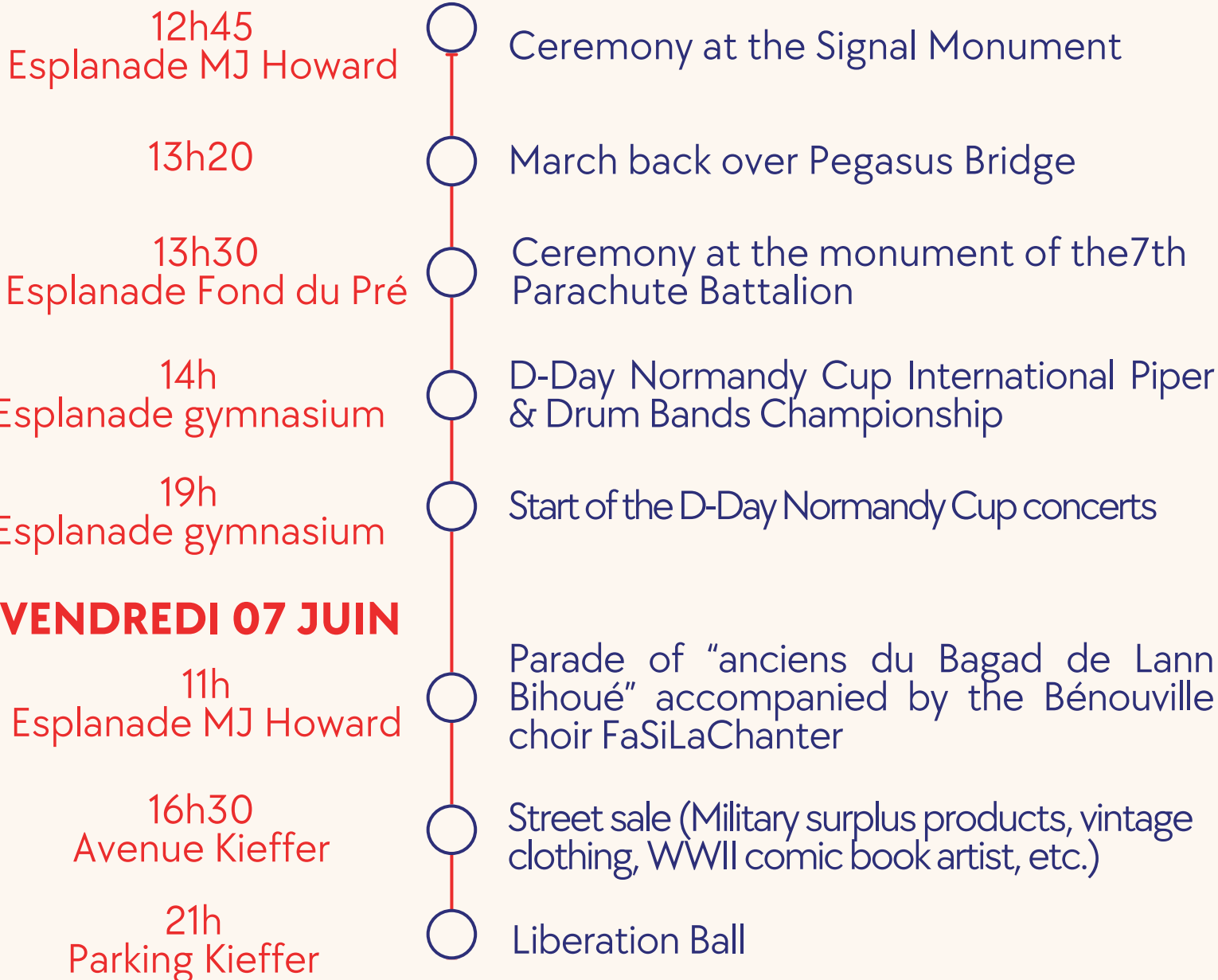

Avenue Kieffer and Pont Pegasus closed to traffic:

- 01/06 from 11pm to 1am
- 02/06 from 08h to 10h30
- 05/06 from 9pm to 2am
- 06/06 from 11am to 2.30pm
- 07/06 from 9pm to 11pm subject to change

Closure of local roads:

- 02/06: Avenue du 5 juin and its access roads from 08.40 to 09.50 while the runners pass through
- 06/06: Avenue de la Côte de Nacre and its access roads from 11am to 12.30pm
